possible pairings of fascinating duos, or the addition of double bass for Schubert's glorious "Trout," will form the basis of this vibrant ensemble's programs. There aren't likely to be more compelling interpreters than the members of **ESPRESSIVO!** 

The Dvořák E-flat and the Brahms G minor (with its whirling ending) always bring the audience to their feet, as will each concert lovingly played by **ESPRESSIVO!** Treat your audience to this great new quartet and maybe even participate in commissioning an exciting new work for them.

Anna, Jaime, Milena, and Sharon look forward to sharing these musical gems with your audience, as they will do with audiences in Florida, Ohio and New York, among others.
