Written for the LAGQ, each of its first four movements is tailored to a different member's musical tastes. "Traditional flamenco, Brazilian and Sephardic idioms commingle in the finale, creating a group portrait of the quartet and a personal vision of world music. The LAGQ members are fabulous shape-shifters, eagerly trying on melodic styles like Mardi Gras costumes. And Assad knows how to exploit their technical flair. [Assad's] expertise shows in natural guitar writing and in transparent orchestration that lets the lightest plink be heard. Mini cadenzas gave each guitarist a chance to shine — building up to a dramatic group cadenza to kick off the fifth movement...it's hard to imagine any group but the fearless LAGQ playing it."
